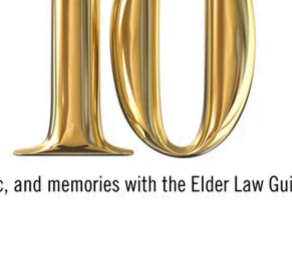


## April 17th: Elder Law Guidance Turns 10 years old, come celebrate with us!

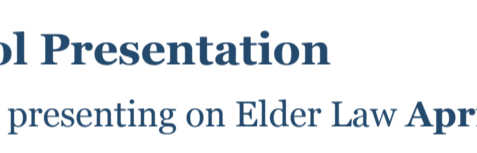
